Success Story – Let's Go Margate

Let's Go Margate was planned and delivered by Future Creative in the build up to the opening of the Turner Contemporary. Hosted by Margate's Winter Gardens, the event was aimed at raising young people's awareness of the opportunities available to them in the arts and culture in Margate. 400 year 9 pupils, college students and teachers experienced arts and cultural workshops delivered by local businesses and artists. The day ended with an address from the mayor, and a performance from local band Scream Don't Whisper. In its management of the day, Future Creative liaised with the venue, workshop providers and schools, organising attendance lists, catering, coaches for schools, and overall running of the day, alongside Thanet District council. The event was filmed, and a full pre and post evaluation process took place, alongside an impact presentation that was delivered back to the commissioning body.
